OUR STORY

iFlestal A Celebration of Latino Culture is a free, family-friendly festival that celebrates Latino heritage and diversity in the Cedar Valley.

In presenting the event, our goal is to provide the community and visitors with a chance to experience Latinx traditions through the presentation of music, authentic cuisine, and the opportunity to meet and interact with the Latinos in lowa.

This event has been a part of Cedar Valley social life for more than 12 years with a few updates to the name, season, event location and time frame along the way. From its origin as a Cinco de Mayo festival and later as Fiesta de Mayo, it has evolved to become iflestal A Celebration of Latino Culture as it has grown beyond a simple holiday celebration to focus on the rich and diverse heritage and culture of all of the Latin American Countries.

Special features include taqueria trucks and other Latinx food vendors, live entertainment, traditional dance performances, and children's activities including cultural crafts, games (among them the beloved piñata), and face painting.



LATINO CULTURE IN WATERLOO

According to U.S. Census Bureau data, more than 7% of Waterloo residents identify themselves as being of Hispanic or Latinx descent. The City of Waterloo is proud to be home to a broad and diverse Hispanic and Latinx community that contributes greatly to the social, cultural, economic, and political strength of the community. During the week of ¡Fiesta!, Waterloo Mayor, Quentin Hart, proclaims ¡Fiesta! day as Waterloo's Latino Heritage Day.

Hispanic and Latinx citizens represent leaders in politics, business, education, the arts, entertainment, the military, science, technology, athletics, medicine, and law, and are **CRITICAL** to building a stronger nation for future generations.

IMPACT

In 2023, ¡FIESTA! A Celebration of Latino Culture saw approximately 1,500 people in attendance at the festival. In spite of a brief rain shower, attendees eagerly queued for food from our four authentic lowa Latinx food vendors. As well as supporting local businesses, this festival connects attendees with many local non-profit organizations and provides quality community programming.

RECOGNITION

¡FIESTA! commemorates the essential contributions, sacrifices, and accomplishments that Hispanic and Latinx Americans have made to the United States throughout our nation's history.

A special visual component at this festival is the proud display of flags from the 21 Latin American nations at the RiverLoop Amphitheatre alongside the riverbank.

STRIVING FOR INCLUSION

¡FIESTA! contributes to the building of a community that is open and welcoming to all who are interested in learning about Latinx culture as well as those with heritage connecting to Latin America and beyond.

ENRICHMENT

In 2023, traditional dances included Folklorico, Salsa, the Dance of Fire and the Dance of the Cardinal Directions from the Aztec tradition.

Also in 2023, local Quiñceaeras were invited to wear and present their unique showstopping dresses and to discuss their individual celebrations.
